WHAT TO SEE



Wat Bowonniwet Vihara

Start your day with a glimpse into Thai history. Featuring a 14th Century statue of Buddha, this classical temple has served as a training and ordination site for several kings of Thailand. Be sure

not to miss the golden stupa, a shrine that contains priceless relics from the royal family.
